- ### Purpose
- Track and evaluate the effectiveness of your implementation efforts
 - Developing an implementation monitoring plan is one of the 9 elements required by the U.S. EPA to develop a complete, comprehensive and successful watershed protection plan
 - Track progress in meeting water quality standards and WPP water quality goals
 - Measurable progress is critical to ensuring continued support of watershed projects

- ### Recommended Plan
- Maintain mainstem monitoring at a frequency of once per month
 - Lake Granbury at DeCordova Dam
 - Lake Granbury at US Business 377
 - Lake Granbury at FM 51
 - Reduce number of cove monitoring sites to just those of concern until implementation of management measures is complete
 - Maintain monthly monitoring
 - As management measures are completed increase monitoring sites in specific area for two years
