Mrs. Johnson is a retired chemist and environmental consultant specializing in state and federal environmental regulatory agencies on water issues. She was elected by her fellow Board members to the position of assistant presiding officer for the Brazos River Authority Board in 2008.

During her more than 30 years with The Dow Chemical Company – North America, she provided consulting services for their Texas operations wastewater permits that cover over 80 plants and departments. She has also consulted on wastewater permit issues throughout the country.

She is the vice-chairperson of Texas Chemical Council's Water and Waste Management Committee where she serves as an advocate for the chemical industry in Texas.

Mrs. Johnson earned a Bachelor of Chemistry degree with a minor in German Language from Lamar University. She has been honored by Dow with such awards as the Dow "Visible Scientist," Dow's first female Environmental Consultant and the Martin Luther King Award.
