Brief Introduction: Since 1938, United Cooperative Services has provided power to the rural homes and businesses of North Texas. Headquartered in Cleburne, Texas, United is an electric distribution cooperative serving approximately 65,725 meters and more than 49,000 members. United was formed from a consolidation of Johnson County Electric Cooperative and Erath County Electric Cooperative in April 2000. Maintaining more than 9,125 miles of energized line, United serves all or parts of Johnson, Erath, Hood, Bosque, Somervell, Palo Pinto, Coryell, Eastland, Comanche, Stephens, Young, Hamilton, Tarrant and Ellis counties.

Agency/Entity Interest in the North Bosque Watershed: Due to the fact that United provides power to much of the North Bosque Watershed, it has a natural interest in the economic development of the region.
