System Operation Permit Water Management Plan Reservoir Fisheries Guidelines

- Sys Ops Texas Parks and Wildlife Department (TPWD) MOU
- Operating guidelines to manage impacts from water-level fluctuations on fisheries
- Guidelines included in the Sys Ops Water Management Plan
 - Unique reservoir thresholds below which fishery habitat is significantly reduced
 - Work with TPWD to mitigate the negative effects of prolonged, low water levels




Fisheries Habitat Improvement Project

- Recent multi-year drought
- Lake Proctor, Lake Granbury, Possum Kingdom Lake
- TPWD Inland Fisheries staff
- Individual plan for each lake
- Coordinate placement of artificial structures with Lake Staff
- Total cost of project \$15,000




Lake Proctor

Operating Guideline Threshold




Lowest Elevation During Recent Drought
