RE: Application for 2021 Interruptible Water

Dear Customer:

The purpose of this notice is to advise potential Interruptible Water customers of the application process for 2021 Interruptible Water. You are receiving this letter because you have contracted with the Brazos River Authority (BRA) for an Interruptible Water Availability Agreement(s) (IWAA) within the last five years or hold a current long-term contract. If you are a current Interruptible Water customer, the terms and conditions of your existing IWAA will remain in effect through the terms specified in your agreement. No action is required unless your existing IWAA expires at the end of 2020 or you desire to contract for additional water.

An application form is attached. The application form must be completed, signed, and received by the BRA at our Waco office by 5:00 p.m. on Monday, August 31, 2020, along with the required application fee and deposit, if applicable. If the BRA has not received your completed application, application fee, and deposit (deposit only required for requests of 500 acre-feet or more) by the close of business on August 31, you will not be considered for Interruptible Water in 2021 unless there is unsold water remaining after all requests received by the deadline have been satisfied. Here are a few things to remember considering the current Interruptible Water Sale Procedure:

- All new IWAAs will be for a term of one year from January 1 to December 31, 2021.
- Adjustments to the amount requested in the application form will not be authorized after the August 31 deadline.
- The BRA Board of Directors will consider the amount of Interruptible Water to be made available in 2021 at the BRA's October Board Meeting.
- If the total of all customer requests exceeds the amount of Interruptible Water available for sale in 2021, your request may be subject to proration. You will have the option of accepting the prorated amount of Interruptible Water or canceling your request.
- If there is sufficient Interruptible Water for new contracts in 2021, the BRA expects to mail new 2021 IWAAs and requests for payment immediately following the BRA's October Board Meeting. You must return the signed IWAA with full payment to the BRA by December 15, 2020; no exceptions to the deadline will be made.
