“WHEREAS, the Brazos River Authority, City of Abilene, and the West Central Texas Municipal Water District executed an Interlocal Agreement in 2005 to address respective water rights and water right applications; and

WHEREAS, the Brazos River Authority, City of Abilene, and the West Central Texas Municipal Water District executed an Amendment to Interlocal Agreement to address specified conditions and clarify provisions within the 2005 Interlocal Agreement; and



“**WHEREAS**, the Brazos River Authority, City of Abilene, and the West Central Texas Municipal Water District desire to effectuate specified terms of the 2005 Interlocal Agreement and to reflect the parties endeavors;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the Brazos River Authority hereby authorizes the General Manager/CEO to execute the Second Amendment to Interlocal Agreement with the City of Abilene and the West Central Texas Municipal Water District.”
